

Transitioning to First Contact Roles in Primary Care

Are you a Registered Allied Health Professional new to or planning a move into a First Contact Role in Primary Care?

If so, then this new inter-professional unit developed in partnership between HEE Wessex Primary Care Training Hubs and Bournemouth University is designed to help you with this transition

- You will gain an understanding of the opportunities and challenges of the first contract role, reflect on the contrast between primary and secondary care and the implication for this in relation to your scope of practice.
- It will examine the knowledge, professional, clinical and leadership skills required for the role and service redesign in line with the NHS Long Term Plan as well as measuring both value and impact for the people using the service and the wider healthcare system. Content includes personalised care; social prescribing; Making Every Contact Count; mental health and wellbeing; Red flag recognition; psychology and management of pain; collaborative leadership; governance in primary care.
