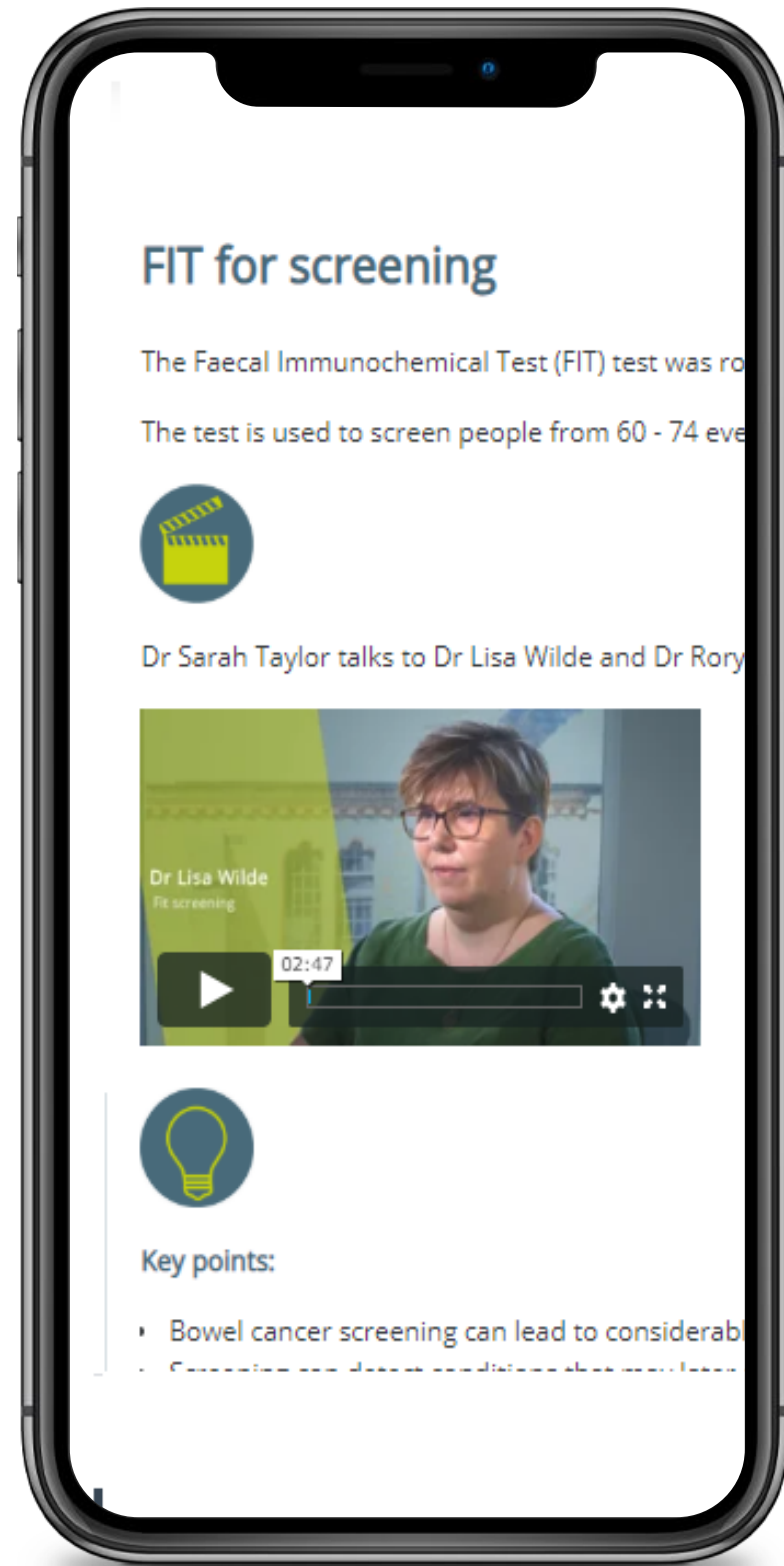

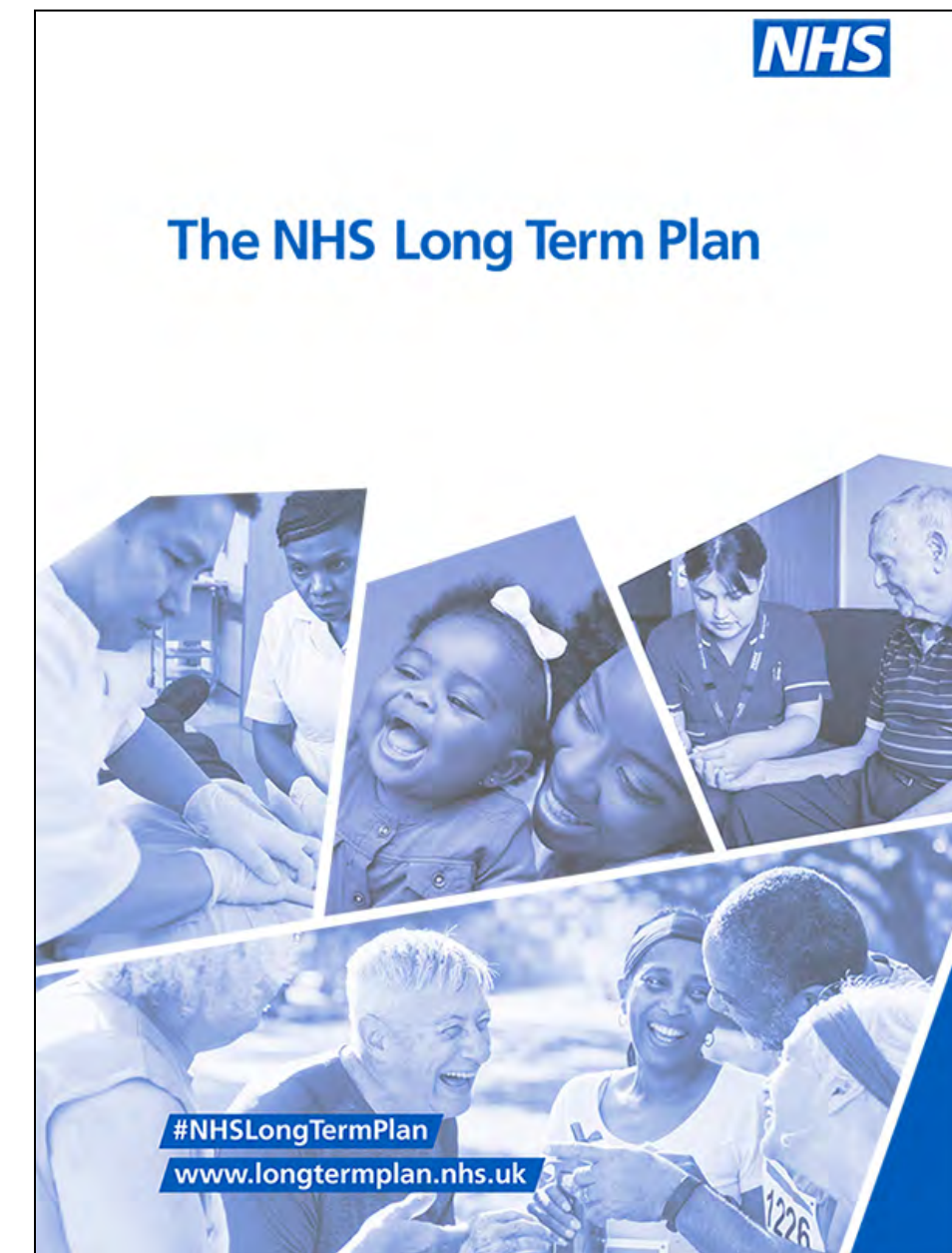
NHS Long Term Plan

By 2028, the NHS will diagnose 75% of cancers at stage 1 or 2.

Patients diagnosed early, at stages 1 and 2, have the best chance of curative treatment and long-term survival.”

We will build on work to raise **greater awareness of symptoms of cancer.**

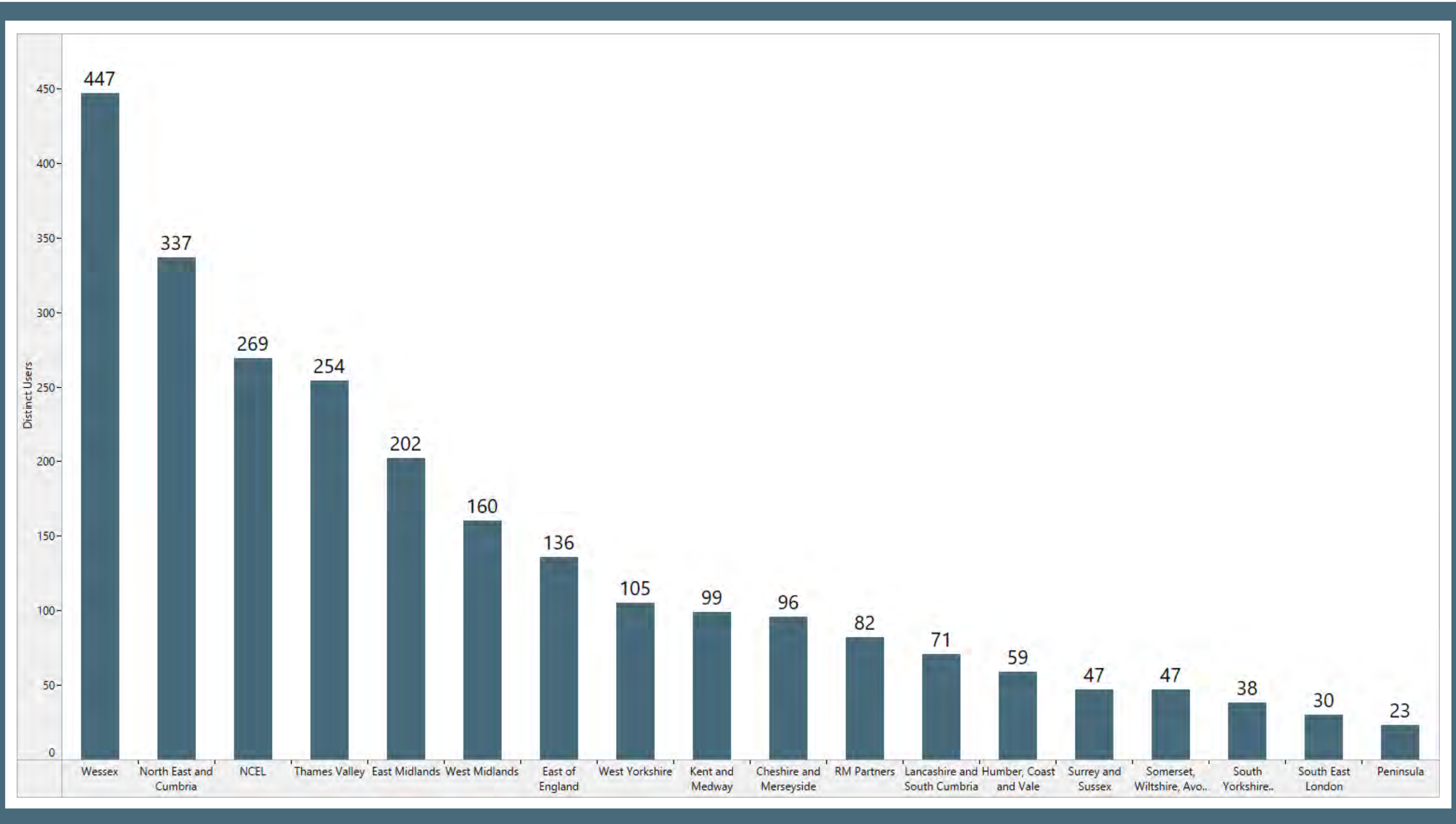
