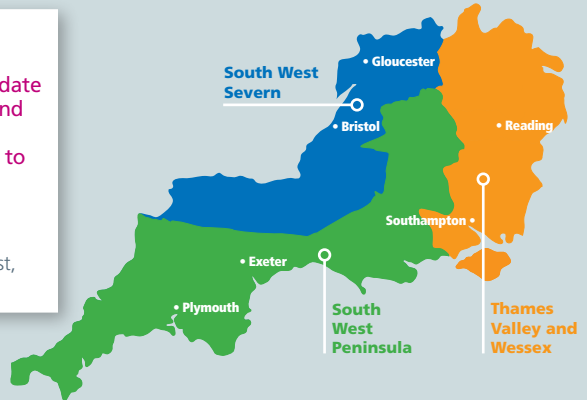


# Pharmacy Foundation Training Programme - South

The South region is a great place to start your pharmacy career. There are more than 140 posts across numerous training sites in the South. These posts provide excellent opportunities to shape you into the pharmacists of the future.

Training posts include a variety of hospital and integrated placements across a variety of sectors, including general practice, primary care networks, community pharmacy, mental health and CCG. This gives you the best chance to make your foundation training year suited to you, as well as enable you to learn with and from fellow trainee pharmacists undertaking their training in other pharmacy settings.

The regional programme in the South is carefully designed to help you pass your foundation training year, and support you in developing the skills and knowledge required of a competent pharmacist.



**The regional programme also includes:**

- 4 regional courses
- 10 Local Learning Set days
- OSCEs
- Audit projects
- Support for the registration exam



**Local Learning Set days run once a month and cover the following topics:**  
 Surgical Specialities, Respiratory, Infections, Cardiovascular, Endocrine, Mental Health, Technical Services, Neurology and Paediatrics. These teaching days are run in small groups and are taught by specialists of these areas.
