Our learners need to understand the needs of the population.

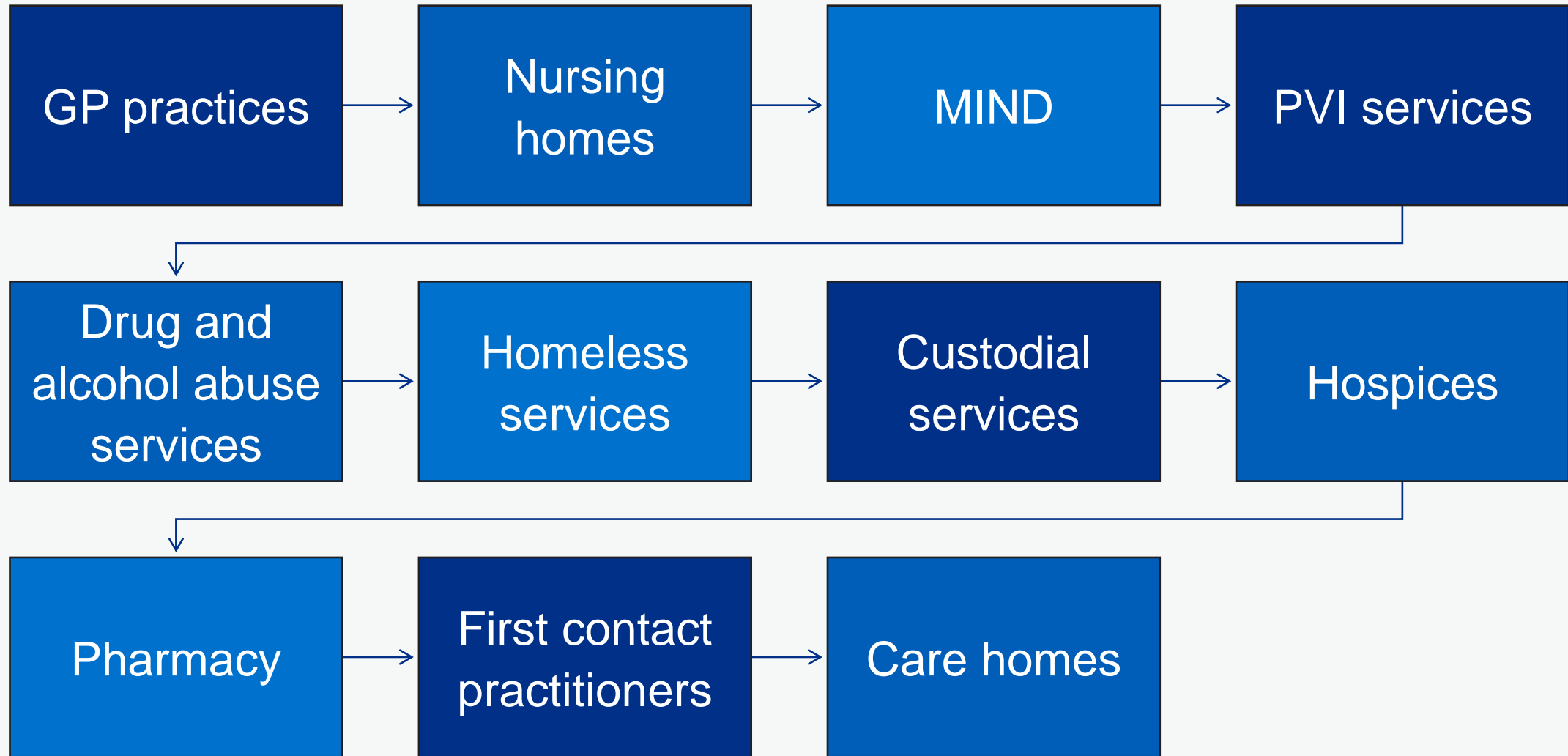

Each PCN will have their own patient demographic and linked services that together create novel placement opportunities.

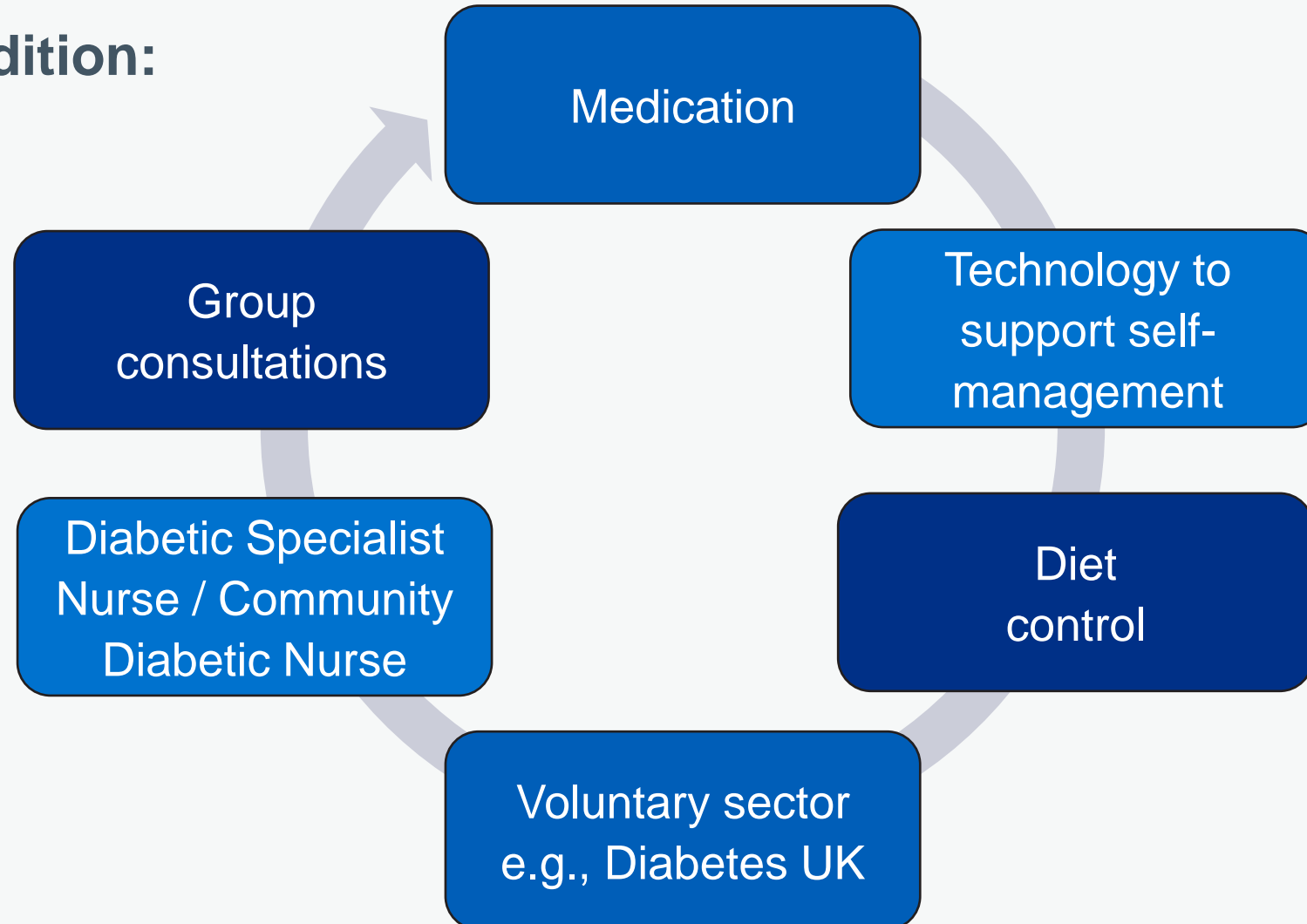
