Student data collection end June for mid-February to June placement activity – finance schedule to HEI requesting them to invoice NHS England late August. HEI or ICB Training Hub to remunerate practice / PCN in September / October

Student data collection end October for July to October placement activity - finance schedule to HEI requesting them to invoice NHS England late December. HEI or ICB Training Hub to remunerate practice / PCN in January / February

Student data collection mid-February for November to mid-February placement activity - finance schedule to HEI requesting them to invoice NHS England late May. HEI or ICB Training Hub to remunerate practice / PCN in June / July
